Agreement with Watts Gallery

The Compton Village Assocation (CVA) and Watts Gallery (WG) entered into a Joint Venture Agreement on 9 March 2016 to acquire a new Minibus to be owned by Watts Gallery. The funds for this acquisition were provided by the CVA, £15,000 as a grant and £16,320 as a six year interest-free loan, which has since been repaid in full.

The new Minibus entered service at the end of January 2017. The CVA hires the Minibus from WG to meet its own operational requirements.
